#### Around the outside

First impressions are certainly lasting in this case. Elegant is not usually a word related to a motorhome but the two-tone Brilliant Silver Metallic and Atlantic Blue Pearl paint job make this one a standout. Locker and window frames are also coloured to match the paintwork and the chrome wheel trims give a very professional

finish to the whole job - it's attractive from any angle.

Lots of lockers for every purpose and eventuality include external shower, slide-out battery/air filter, slide-out barbecue, two under-floor and one rear storage locker which did not initially appear overly large but extends the full vehicle width and will easily house boogie boards, buckets and
